

For television, Davidson directed films for Hallmark and ABC-TV. Other television credits include the first Law and Order, Picket Fences, Chicago Hope, Our Family Honor, Call to Glory, and Judging Amy.

An independent producer and a consultant in marketing and distribution of independent films. He is also a Professor of Professional Practice in the School of the Arts at Columbia University, where he was the Chair of the Film Program from 2011-2015. Ira has been making, marketing and distributing films since 1975, having worked on over 150 films including some of the most successful independent films of all time. He was one of the founders of Cinecom and later created Fine Line Features. He was also a co-founder of Emerging Pictures, the first digital projection network in the United States and a pioneer in delivering live cultural events into movie theaters.

Chester Algernal Gordon

A producer and costume designer on several projects that have played in over 200 festivals combined including Cannes, SXSW, Outfest, and the American Black Film Festival. Gordon's produced documentary Pier Kids won a spirit award in 2021 and was nominated for a GLAAD award in 2022. Gordon is the winner of the Tribeca Film Institute's 2019, TFI All Access Grant and was also a Film Independent 2019 Producing Lab & Fast Track Lab fellow. Gordon was a part of the teams of five Sundance films, winning best U.S. narrative short twice, and served as a costume designer in Danielle Lessovitz's Port Authority and is currently producing Elegance Bratton's debut narrative feature, The Inspection with A24 & Gamechanger.

Meredith Kaulfers

A proud New Jersey native, Meredith started in scripted indies and short films before moving to documentaries, and worked on a wide range of projects for some of the biggest networks and streaming services, such as Apple TV+, HBO, ESPN+, and more. Currently she is the SVP of Current production at Imagine Documentaries, the unscripted division of Ron Howard and Brian Grazer's Imagine Entertainment, which has been a leader in premium storytelling across film and television for over 35 years. She recently produced Howard's documentary feature film We Feed People and is proud to have produced several films that played at the Lighthouse International Film Festival: Local Tourists, Little Horses and most recently John Bronco.
